#### **Mission**

Tualatin Riverkeepers (TRK) is a community-based organization working to protect and restore Oregon's Tualatin River system. TRK builds watershed stewardship through education, public access to nature, restoration and advocacy.

#### **Position Description**

Cook Park Boat Rentals Staff will rent canoes and kayaks to the public on a first-come-first-serve basis. Our boat rentals are popular in the summertime, and they often sell out early in the high season. This is a physically demanding position that includes lifting of canoes and kayaks weighing 30 - 88 lbs, frequent standing and movement throughout the shift. This position requires explaining TRK's mission and programs to the public as well as encouraging the public to become members of Tualatin Riverkeepers. Applicants must demonstrate ability to provide great customer service in a timely and organized manner while keeping cool under pressure.

Staff will work 20-30 hours per week at Cook Park Boat Rentals located in Tigard's Cook Park at 17005 SW 92nd Avenue. Regular shifts are typically Friday-Sunday, but there will also be some weekday work that includes training, weekday trips, facility set up and take down.

- Experience paddling canoes and/or kayaks
- Ability to lift and maneuver canoes and kayaks (50 lbs or more)
- Familiarity with paddling (canoe/kayak) gear
- Enjoy working with a diverse public
- Excellent communication and organizational skills

- Commitment to TRK's mission
