## **Organization Description:**

The Tualatin Riverkeepers is a community based organization working to protect and restore Oregon's Tualatin River system. The Tualatin Riverkeepers builds watershed stewardship through public education, access to nature, citizen involvement and advocacy.

## **Position Description:**

Volunteer members of the Education Committee provide administrative support to the Riverkeepers' *Nature Awareness and Service Education* program. The committee ensures that Nature Awareness and Service stays current and remains in line with the Tualatin Riverkeepers mission statement to help students in grades K-8 develop curiosity and awareness about the natural spaces in their neighborhood and watershed.

Volunteers will:

- Meet with the Riverkeepers' Environmental Education coordinator for specific training.
- Continue educator/school outreach strategies and implementation.
- Schedule program and coordinate program requirements and forms.
- Stays updated on existing outdoor education programs, educational benchmarks, and integrate relevant information.
- Serve as an advocate for *Nature Awareness and Service Education* by understanding the program and its connection to TRK.
