Tualatin Riverkeepers (TRK) trips are open to all members and the general public. Space is limited and reservations are required.

***There is a trip charge of \$5 per person for TRK members and \$10 for nonmembers. Canoes are available to members free of charge by reservation. Nonmembers may rent canoes for our paddle trips for \$30. Annual memberships start at \$35.***

Alcohol is not permitted on trips and personal flotation devices must be worn. Trips may be cancelled due to weather conditions. Trip leaders are volunteers, and are not compensated for the time and energy that they put in to making our Trips & Tours program successful. Trips may be canceled if we are unable to recruit sufficient volunteer support to lead a safe and enjoyable trip.
